1ST REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING

JANUARY 8, 2019

Alex Zumbar, Stark County Treasurer introduced the Fix-It Funds Program. This is a low interest, fixed rate home improvement loans for Stark County's Homeowners. The program will be open from April 1 thru September. Loans range from \$5000 to \$50000. Loans are 2% below the bank's current interest rate. No maximum limit on borrower's income. Home value of \$250000 or less are eligible. Three banks including Westfield Bank, First Commonwealth & Farmer's National Bank.
