OCTOBER 27, 2020

The 20th Regular Council Meeting was called to order by Mayor Timothy N. Tarbet after the Lord's Prayer & The Pledge of Allegiance were said.

A drive-by live nativity will be December 12. Small business Saturday will be November 28.

Administrator: Mr. Turske stated there will be bugs with the new audio system. The goal is for everyone to be seen and heard better. We are working on the connection for Facebook live. Last week a flu shot clinic was held for employees covered under the village health plan. The PD received a grant from the Stark County Emergency Management Agency for a Bleed Control Kit. We received the initial application for the GIS Mapping for the cemetery. Eventually, residents will be able to see available graves or locate a loved one. It will be awhile before we get it out to the public due to the entry of data.

Hinges had to be replaced. Hydrant flushing completed 10/24, water plant pumped 1.2MG. Waste Water Dept.: Received Minerva Dairy self-reporting data and supporting documents for September 2020, not effluent violations. Minerva WWTP also obtained several grab samples, no violations. Park Dept.: Keeping up with leaf mulching. Bowman removed trees at Mayor's Park. Park dept. ground stumps. Misc.: Completed high strength influent EPA training. Zoning: iWorQ zoning/nuisance software went live 10/09/2020 ahead of schedule. Current cases- see iWorQ case sheet. JT stated a presentation will be done at Council to show residents how to utilize the program for complaints and or permits.
