Requirements

1. Application must be approved.
2. Any bulk waste container placed on a street, sidewalk, or public right-of-way shall bear reflectorized or illuminated marking. If no markings are on the container, orange safety cones are to be placed on all traffic sides.
3. Permit is valid for thirty (30) days. Permits may be renewed at the discretion of the Service Director. Any bulk waste container that is filled to capacity must be emptied or removed within three (3) calendar days thereof.
4. Dumpster cannot exceed 40 cubic yards in any R-1, R-2, R-3 or R-4 district.
5. Penalty of violating any provisions is loss of permit and fine.

BULK WASTE CONTAINER shall be defined as a roll off container, utility trailer or bag type container that is intended to contain waste, generally construction and demolition debris or other bulk waste, and is loaded onto a specialty vehicle or transported by a motor vehicle for disposal.

737.02. PERMIT REQUIRED.

For any property used as a residence in any zoning district in the Village, no person shall place or cause to be placed upon any property, street, sidewalk, alley or public right-of-way within the Village any bulk waste container, without first having obtained a written permit from the utilities office by making an on-line application or by an in-person application at the utilities office. It shall be the responsibility of the user of the bulk waste container to obtain a permit and to provide a copy of such permit to the owner of the bulk waste container before placement of any bulk waste container. In emergency situations, a bulk waste container may be placed prior to obtaining a permit (see Section 737.03 below). No permit will be required for the placement of a dumpster in any zoning district in the Village or for a bulk waste container for any property used as a commercial or industrial property regardless of the zoning district." 737.04. PERMIT DURATION.

Upon approval of the on-line or in-person permit application, a written permit for placement of a bulk waste container shall be issued by the Village. Permits shall be good for a period of thirty (30) days from the date of issuance. Provided that the permit holder has complied with the requirements of this Chapter and the permit issued hereunder, the permit may be renewed for additional periods of thirty (30) days. No permit fee shall be required to obtain a permit or any renewal thereof, but the Village reserves the right to charge a fee at any time by ordinance or resolution. (Ord. 35-23. 737.05. PERMIT CONDITIONS.

... (d) After any bulk waste container is filled to capacity, the same shall be emptied or caused to be emptied or removed within three calendar days thereof. If removed, a replacement bulk waste container shall be permitted for the remainder of the thirty (30) days from permit issuance, subject to the requirement for permit renewal upon termination of the permit. 737.06 PERMIT REVOCATION.

Any permit issued or renewed by the Village may be immediately revoked by the Village upon mailing of notice of revocation to the permit holder at the address stated in the permit application, or by service of the Service Director/Zoning Inspector or his/her designee, for any one of the following reasons:

- (a) Failure to comply with any provision of this Chapter or any requirement as set forth in the permit or permit application;
- (b) The emission of any foul or noxious odor from material contained in the bulk waste container, regardless of whether the bulk waste container is filled to capacity or not; or
- (c) The presence of any vehicular, pedestrian, fire, health or safety hazard or potential hazard arising after issuance of a permit or renewal thereof.

737.99 PENALTY.

(a) Any person violating any provision of this Chapter shall be guilty of a minor misdemeanor, and shall be fined pursuant to Section [501.99\(a\)\(2\)E.](#) of the Codified Ordinances.

(b) Each separate violation of any section of this Chapter shall be considered a separate minor misdemeanor.

(c) Upon revocation of any permit granted or renewed by the Village, failure to remove any bulk waste container for which a permit has been revoked shall constitute a separate violation for each day after revocation. Except in emergency situations as set forth in Section [737.03](#), for each day that a bulk waste container is placed without having obtained a permit therefore, a separate violation shall exist. The Village shall have the right to remove any said bulk waste container from a Village Street, sidewalk, alley or public right-of way.
